1. Faculty Position: Assistant Professor for CO₂ Fixation Project directed by Prof. Nobuharu Iwasawa in Department of Chemistry, School of Science, Tokyo Institute of Technology

2. Research Field: Organic chemistry related to organometallic chemistry, photochemistry, synthetic organic chemistry, etc. The project will focus on development of CO₂ fixation reactions.

3. Term of Employment: Annual contract. Depending on the achievement, the term can be extended until March 31, 2022; Salary will be determined according to the University's Salary Regulations for Employee with Annual Salary.

3. Qualification Requirements: Applicants are required to have or will have Doctoral degree or Ph. D by the end of March 2018.

4. Start of Employment: As early as possible after decision.
